### TRUST DEED

#### SUMMARY

An agreement between the Moroccan British Society (MBS) and Saint Antony's College of Oxford University was completed on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2004.

#### **According to the Agreement;**

- 1. The MBS shall make available an endowment to support the establishment of His Majesty Mohammed VI Fellowship in Moroccan and Mediterranean Studies.*
- 2. Saint Antony's College will use the returns to hire a permanent Fellow to teach courses, research topics, and supervise students in the area of Moroccan and Mediterranean Studies.*
- 3. Both of the MBS and Saint Antony's College will work towards raising funds to provide scholarships to support students interested in the program.*
- 4. MBS transferred the endowment funds on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2004 and Saint Antony's College appointed Dr. Michael Willis to take the Fellowship starting October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2004.*

#### **The main duties of His Majesty King Mohammed VI Fellow will be:**

1. To teach various courses on Morocco and the Mediterranean region,
2. To supervise research undertaken by Oxford students interested in Morocco and the Mediterranean,
3. To conduct advanced research and publication in Moroccan and Mediterranean Studies,
4. To promote Moroccan British relations through the organization of cultural and scientific events.
